



- **YOU HAVE THE FUNDAMENTAL RIGHT TO PROTEST UNDER THE FIRST AMENDMENT OF THE U.S. CONSTITUTION.**
- **YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO TAKE PHOTOS AND RECORD, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO RECORD THE POLICE. THE POLICE CAN ORDER YOU TO STOP RECORDING IF YOU ARE DISRUPTING *LEGITIMATE* POLICE BUSINESS BUT RECORDING FROM A SAFE DISTANCE IS *NOT* INTERFERING. POLICE CANNOT TAKE THESE IMAGES OR RECORDINGS FROM YOU WITHOUT A WARRANT. THEY ALSO CANNOT DELETE THEM FROM YOUR PHONE.**
- **HENNEPIN COUNTY HAS A REGULAR CURFEW FOR YOUTH UNDER 18 (GOOGLE HENNEPIN COUNTY CURFEW FOR MORE INFO). EXERCISING YOUR FIRST AMENDMENT, INCLUDING PROTESTING, MAKES BEING OUT PAST CURFEW EXCUSABLE UNDER THE LAW.**
- **BUT IF YOU ARE OUT PAST THE CURFEWS IMPOSED BY MANY CITIES FOLLOWING THE MURDER OF GEORGE FLOYD, EVEN IF YOU'RE OUT PEACEFULLY PROTESTING, THEN YOU COULD GET A TICKET OR BE ARRESTED.**
- **IF YOU ARE STOPPED OR ARRESTED FOR ANY REASON, ASSERT THE FOLLOWING RIGHTS WHEN INTERACTING WITH POLICE (SWIPE FOR MORE INFORMATION)**
